Founded in 2001, the Guivy Zaldastanishvili American Academy in Tbilisi (American Academy in Tbilisi) is a private, coeducational day school enrolling 366 students in grades 8 through 12.

Central to our teaching is the Harkness method, borrowed from Phillips Exeter Academy in the United States. Our founding teachers have undergone extensive training in the Harkness method at Philips Exeter Academy and have earned Master's degrees in Education from Harvard and Simmons Universities.

Our mission is to offer a rigorous education to prepare our students to enter universities in Georgia, Europe, the UK, and the USA, as well as to be a model for education reform in Georgia.

Admission to the Academy is highly competitive, entailing rigorous in-house testing in Georgian, English, and mathematics, along with an interview with the Admissions Committee. Students who achieve the highest combined scores in these assessments are offered admission. The first senior class graduated in 2005.

**Great Ideas\*** a team-taught interdisciplinary course designed to prepare students for college-level studies. Readings include original sources (Plato, Leonardo, Galileo, Darwin, Freud, Einstein, etc.) and related literature. Students meet in sections three times and attend one double-period lecture per week.

## Graduation Requirement: 25 credits

**Unweighted GPA (scale 4.0):** Because of a highly competitive admissions process and the outstanding reputation of the school, we attract the most talented students in Georgia. GPAs are skewed to higher levels, not because of grade inflation but rather because so many of them perform exceptionally well.

**Juries (oral exam for freshmen and sophomores):** Freshmen and sophomores undergo juries (oral exams) in all six of their subjects at the end of the year. These exams are testing the students' abilities to respond to a set of questions about material they have never seen before. Students must pass their juries
